How is a Lavender Fund set up?

When we receive a donation gift in someone's memory, we can set up and administer a Lavender Fund. Simply complete the form on the back of this leaflet, or on our website or call **01603 619900**.

Each fund is individually named after your friend or loved one and allows friends, family and colleagues to raise money to help Big C.

Once we have processed your Lavender fund set-up form, you will receive an email link to your online page, which you can edit to include your personal story, and share with those who wish to make donations in the future.

How do we help our Lavender Fund grow?

Anyone can contribute to a Lavender Fund in whichever way they choose. You can make a single donation or a regular donation as a **'Friend of Big C'** via a standing order. Some people bake and sell cakes, some run marathons or host events and some make a donation on a significant day, like a birthday or anniversary.

Whatever way you decide, you can rest assured that every penny donated is going to help those, and their families, affected by cancer in Norfolk & Waveney.

“When Lyn was diagnosed, she received a great deal of help and support from Big C. She placed particular value on the Centre at the Norfolk & Norwich Hospital which we visited whenever she had an appointment with her consultant. She used to say that it was somewhere she could go where she felt "normal".

She was initially involved in fundraising for the charity and so setting up a Lavender Fund in her name seemed an ideal way to create a lasting memorial to her, when the time came.
